The Island of Gozo, Malta

Malta is a beautiful island with mild temperatures all year round and over 300 days of sunshine. The island of Gozo is the second largest Island after Malta and forms part of the Maltese archipelago. The island has an area of 26 sq. miles, 13.34km (8.3 miles) in length by 7.15km (4.4 miles). Gozo island is semi-rural in nature and is less developed than the island of Malta. It has been inhabited since 5000BC and was invaded by many different cultures which have left their mark on the island both physically, culturally and spiritually. Gozo is known for its scenic hills and peaceful way of life and it is considered one of the top diving destinations in the Mediterranean.

Getting to Malta:

All the major worldwide airlines that fly directly into Europe have partner airlines flying from Dublin, Manchester, London, Paris, Munich, Frankfurt, Madrid and Rome etc into Malta International Airport. Also many of the European domestic and low cost airlines fly directly into Malta from all over Europe. Please check with your International and/or domestic airlines for direct and indirect routes into Malta International Airport.

Car rental Malta Airport

All the major international car rental companies are based at Malta International Airport. As you come out of the main terminal entrance door, turn right and follow the signs to the multi-story car park and on the second floor you will find all the car rental companies. The car rental return is also at the same multi story car park level. Should this interest you, we advise that you book your car rental well in advance.

Should you wish to transfer to the ferry via your own car rental, ferry details and timetable can be found at the ferry website- https://www.gozochannel.com/ The ferry costs approximately €4.65 (Euro) each way and is only charged on the return trip from Gozo Island to Malta Island. The ferry runs 24 hours a day and leaves every 15 minutes.

Getting to the Retreat Hotel on Gozo Island:

Our partner Hotel, Hotel Ta' Cenc & Spa offers the service of a taxi pick up at Malta International Airport, which will transport you to the Ferry port of Cirkewwa which is approximately a 40 minute drive from the Airport. At Cirkewwa port you will transfer onto the Gozo Ferry which leaves approximately every 15 minutes. The ferry trip length is only around 20 minutes long. When you arrive at the Gozo port of Mgarr, another taxi will be waiting to pick you up and drive you to the Hotel Ta' Cenc, which is a 15 minute drive. If booked via the hotel the return trip to Malta International Airport can be arranged also. The cost of the taxi transfer is €45 each way.

The Weather

Gozo Island is lucky enough to get an average of 300 days of sunshine per year and Malta's climate generally is one of the best in the world with moderate rainfall. It can be windy some days but generally that's in the winter months. Check out our average monthly temperature index below. Please note that Europe is experiencing some very atypical weather so as with most things, sunshine is not guaranteed.



What to bring:

So what to bring! Firstly, swim wear for the indoor or outdoor swimming pools, steam room and jacuzzi. It is advisable to bring light casual clothes so light pants, shorts, t-shirts and casual relaxed wear generally for the retreat is advisable. As Gozo enjoys sunshine 300 plus days a year, please bring your shades, sunhat and some sun protection The evenings can cool down a little so it might be a good idea to bring clothes that allow you to layer up or layer down depending on the time of day. Jeans and a fleece or two for the evenings might be a good idea. If you are a keen walker, the hotel is fronted by extensive walking paths so if that tweaks your interest, please ensure to bring comfortable walking shoes or sneakers.....and as much as we hate to say it, maybe pack a light raincoat...just in case!!!!!

Where you will be staying for the retreat



Hotel Ta' Cenc & Spa is a beautiful boutique style family owned and run hotel which is located within walking distance of Sannat which is a small village in Gozo The village of Sannat is a guiet village with traditional streets and well-kept homes built in the Maittese traditional architecture. It's worth a walk around just to sense the calm, slow Mediterranean pace of life. The village square has a bank, pharmacy, a grocery store and of course a church. The Hotel is renowned for its calm and comforting surroundings. The Hotel surroundings are themselves one of the Hotels many highlights. There are 400 acres of land of archaeological interest surrounding the hotel and this area boasts incredible natural beauty with a variety of indigenous natural fauna and flora. The dramatic cliffside setting on the south side of the island offers enviable views of the Maltese archipelago and is the perfect base for exploring the many sights and sounds of Gozo plus it is a great place to enjoy walks, meditation and view the spectacular sunrise and sunset. There are approximately 13 kilometres of walking trails that you can access from the hotel so you will get to spend plenty of time surrounded by nature. The hotel does not feel too small nor too big which creates a warm, relaxing and intimate atmosphere so you will hopefully feel right at home. The staff are very friendly and they are available at all times to assist you if needed. A member of staff from Souliology will also be available throughout the retreat week if you need help with anything.
